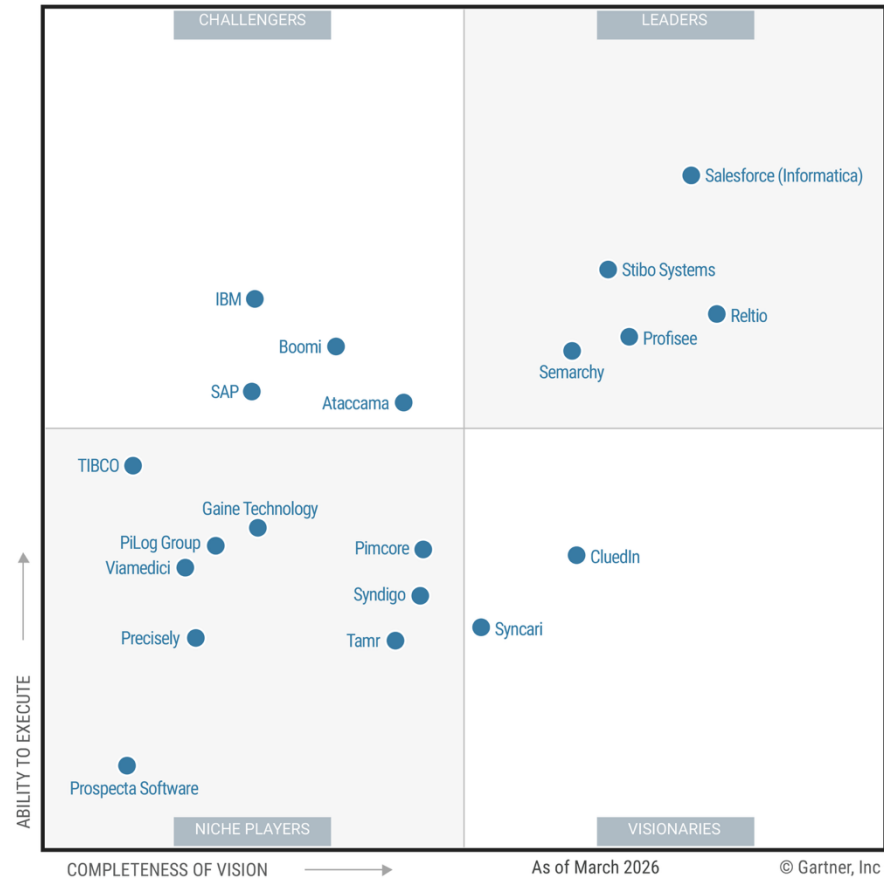

Figure 1: Magic Quadrant for Master Data Management Solutions



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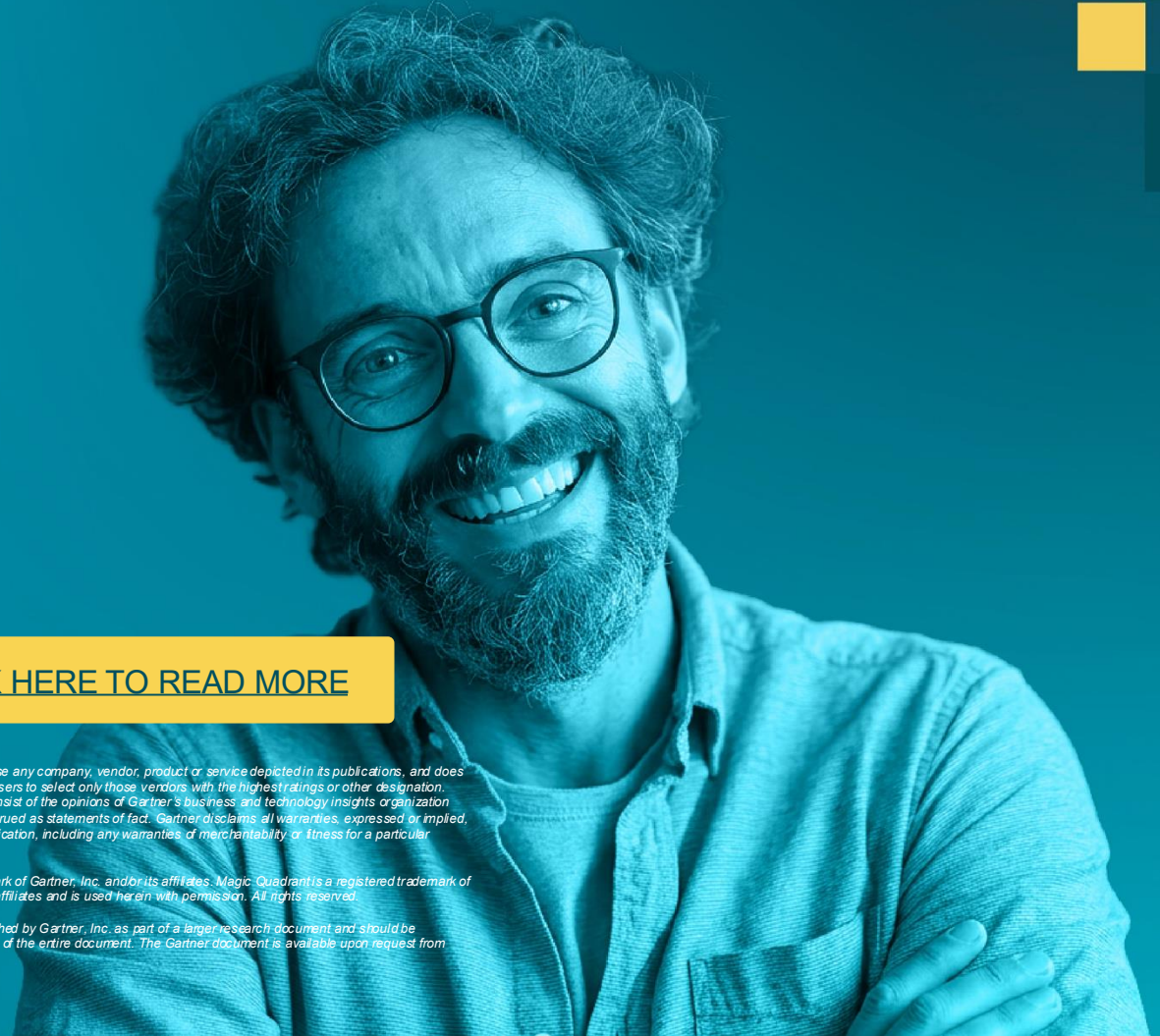
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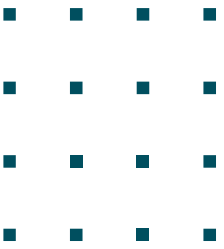

# Consumer MCP Server

**Current Situation** | Agentic AI is increasingly used to reason over enterprise knowledge and support real-world tasks. Yet access to trusted master data is still often enabled through custom, tightly coupled integrations that limit reuse and scalability.

**Challenge** | Without a standard interaction layer, AI agents struggle to consistently discover, understand, and safely access enterprise master data. This increases complexity and makes it difficult to govern and scale agentic use cases over time.

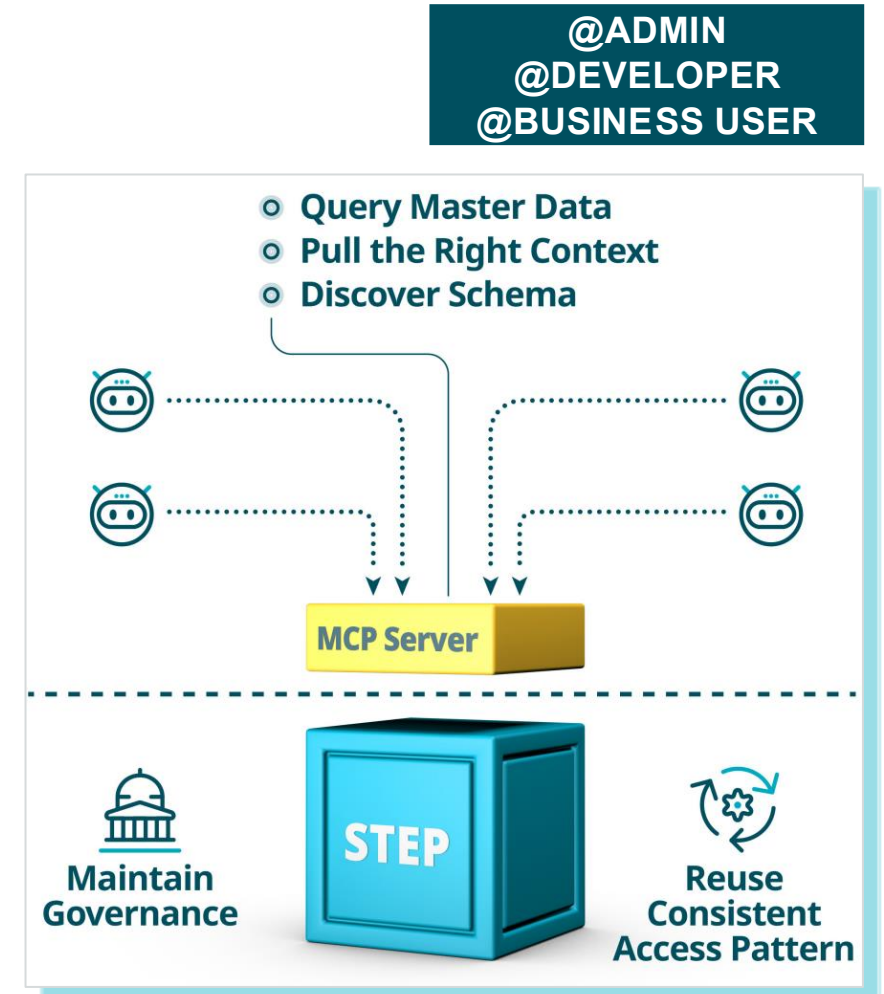
**What's New** | In 2026.2, the Consumer MCP Server is generally available. It provides a governed Model Context Protocol interface that enables large language models and AI agents to discover and access enterprise master data. By building on the capabilities of Data as a Service, it exposes master data with the semantic context needed for AI-driven interaction.

**Expected Benefits** | This decouples AI agents from underlying data implementations while preserving trust, governance, and centralized control. Organizations can scale agentic AI use cases more efficiently, reuse consistent data access patterns, and make enterprise master data more accessible and meaningful for AI-driven interaction.

# Dynamic Parallelism for One Queue

**Current Situation** | The One Queue background processing framework efficiently manages critical processing in STEP, dynamically balancing workloads across integrations, bulk operations, internal processing, and scheduled jobs without complex configuration.

**Challenge** | For background processes that support multithreading, such as large imports, parallel processing capacity has traditionally been statically configured. This can limit throughput when spare capacity is available and often requires manual or temporary adjustments for large or time-critical workloads.

**What's New** | With the 2026.2 update, Dynamic Parallelism has been added to the One Queue framework. Multithreaded background processes can now automatically scale their processing capacity up or down at runtime based on real time availability of processing capacity and overall platform demand.

**Expected Benefits** | Dynamic Parallelism can improve the processing speed for large workloads while maintaining fairness and stability across the platform. It maximizes the use of available processing capacity without manual tuning, reduces operational effort, and thereby supports predictable execution of business-critical workloads.

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# Self-Service UI Improvements

**Current Situation** | The Self-Service UI currently provides limited visibility into user activity and relies on manual provisioning of Control Service API credentials. Login events, platform-initiated changes, external log access, and API credential management are not fully supported.

**Challenge** | Customers need reliable auditability and secure, self-service API key management. Limited visibility and manual provisioning reduce transparency and complicate security, compliance, and monitoring.

**What's New** | The User Activity Log now includes login events and changes performed by Stibo Systems, and is available via the Control Service API. Administrators can now create, scope, renew, and revoke Control Service API credentials directly in the Self-Service UI.

**Expected Benefits** | Customers benefit from a single, consistent audit trail and direct control over API credentials. This improves transparency, strengthens security and compliance, reduces manual provisioning effort, and supports integration with external auditing and monitoring tools.

**Control Service API**  
The Control Service API provides programmatic access to control and monitor the STEP platform.

**Access management**  
Create and manage machine-to-machine accounts for accessing the Control Service API. You can generate, renew, or deactivate keys for accounts identified by a "control-service-" prefix followed by a 20-digit suffix of your choice. Specify which environment types each account can access: Production, Non-Production, or both. For security reasons, key values are displayed only once, immediately after they are generated. Keys expire automatically after one year and must be renewed to remain valid.

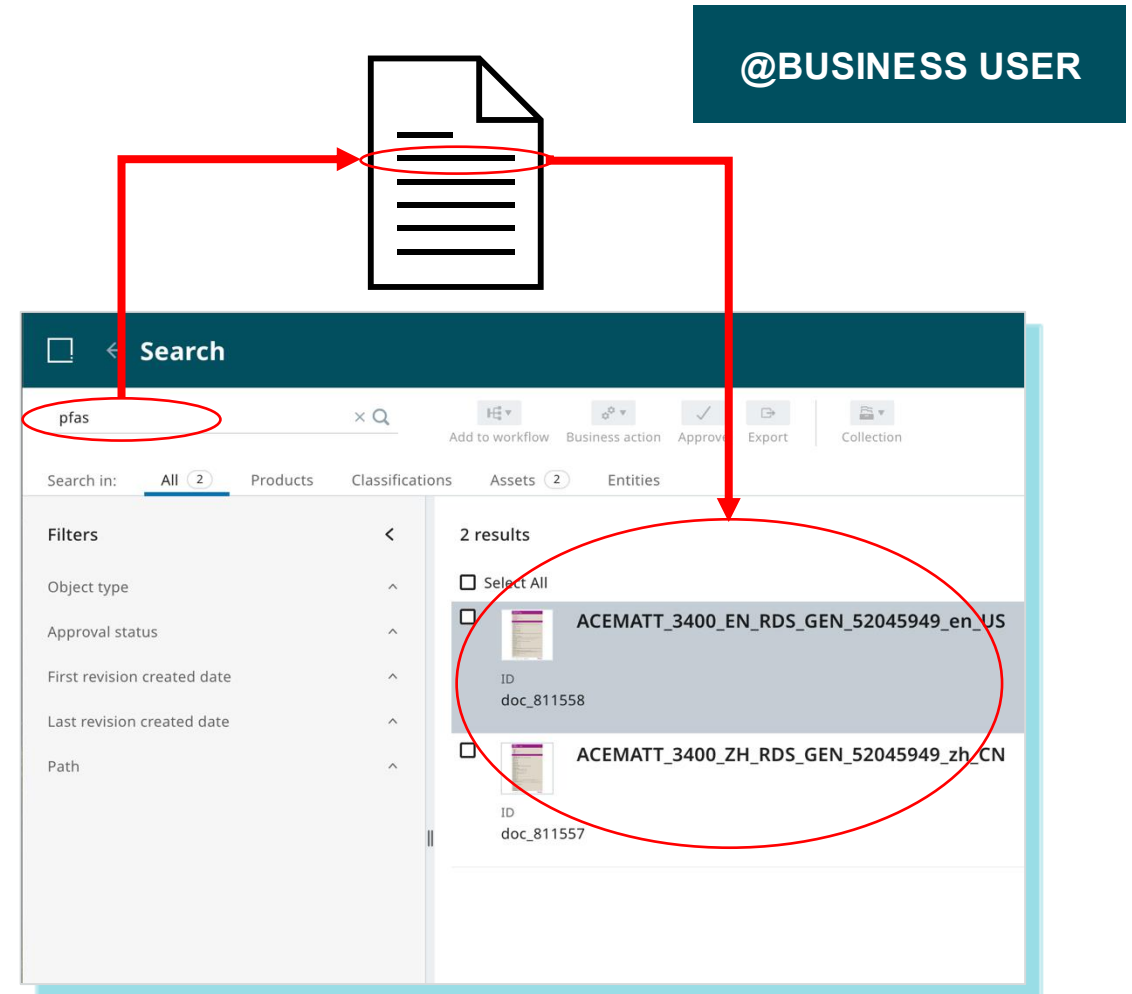
# Faceted Search for Asset Content

**Current Situation |** Users often know an asset by what's inside the document (contracts, certifications, specs, manuals) and need search to match that content, not only metadata/attributes.

**Challenge |** Extend the existing full-text search experience to include textual asset content, while keeping the workflow in Faceted Search.

**What's New |** With 2026.2, Faceted Search can match on text inside assets (e.g., PDFs, Office docs, HTML, text, common CSV-like formats) and return those assets in results, using the same full-text search patterns as today, now extended beyond metadata/attributes. This is available in both the New UI and Faceted Search in Web UI.

**Expected Benefits |** Faster “find the right document” workflows, as users can search by document body content while staying in familiar Faceted Search patterns.

# SMTPS for email Communication

**Current Situation** | Our SaaS platform supports outbound email communication using SMTP with STARTTLS, enabling encrypted connections to customer-managed mail relay servers and meeting baseline security expectations.

**Challenge** | STARTTLS requires protocol negotiation before encryption is enforced, which does not fully align with modern security expectations. As customers adopt stricter security policies, there is a need to ensure email communication is encrypted by default, without fallback to unencrypted connections.

**What's New** | In 2026.2 we add support for SMTPS (Implicit SSL) for outbound email communication. SMTPS enforces TLS encryption immediately when the connection is established and aligns with current industry standards such as RFC 8314. This improvement is part of a broader, ongoing initiative to continuously strengthen the security of the platform.

**Expected Benefits** | Email communication is encrypted from the moment a connection is established, reducing the risk of misconfiguration and eliminating the possibility of unencrypted transport while aligning with modern security and compliance expectations.

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# Multi Edit DC – Node Picker in Create Dialog in Web UI

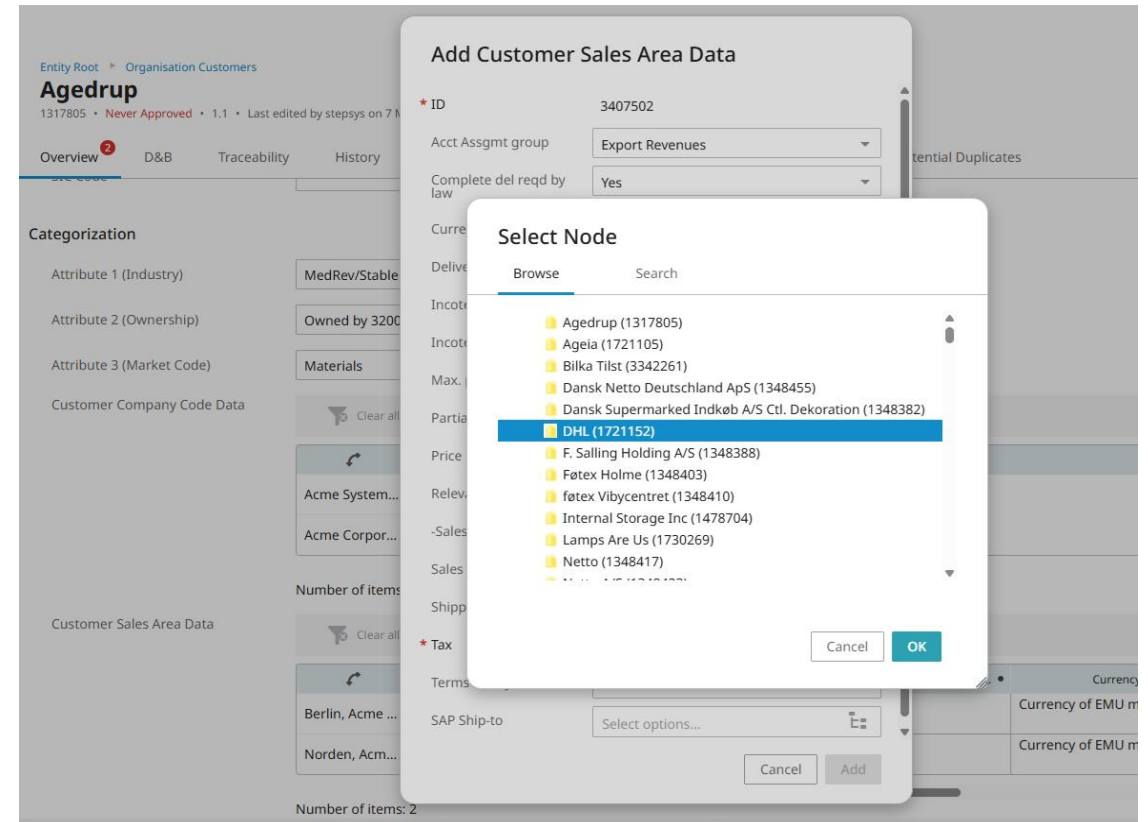

**Current Situation** | After the Multi Edit Data Container (DC) Create dialog was updated to use the same value controls as Unfolding DC, a key capability was missed: reference fields could no longer use a Node Picker.

**Challenge** | Bring back the Node Picker in the Multi Edit DC Create dialog without adding a new configuration toggle, while keeping the shared “Globally Configured Reference” control consistent across contexts.

**What’s New** | With 2026.2, the Globally Configured Reference control now shows a Node Picker in the Multi Edit DC Create dialog. It enables itself automatically only when it detects it’s in the Create dialog and the table’s reference component is configured with a Node Picker.

**Expected Benefits** | Restores feature parity with the older Multi Edit DC behavior and lets users select referenced objects via Node Picker when creating new data containers, matching the expected workflow.

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# Elasticsearch – Improved Reindexing Speed

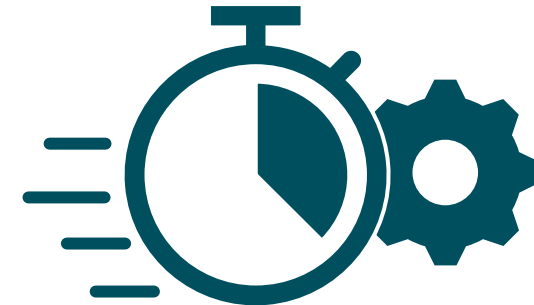

**Current Situation** | Elasticsearch reindexing can be slow for large dataset on larger systems and on small systems as well.

**Challenge** | The reindex process occupies shared workers for the entire duration of reindexing, making little or no room for indexing processes. Additionally, for larger datasets certain operations in the reindexing process cause bottlenecks.

**What's New** | With 2026.2, the reindexing process no longer occupies shared workers, when it is not working and time-consuming work is moved to other processes. Additionally, the batch size of indexing processes spanned by reindexing, is increased.

**Expected Benefits** | In many cases, reindexing will be 2-3 times faster.

# Supplier Management in PDX

**Current Situation** | Supplier onboarding in PDX  
Onboarding can feel long and fragmented, with limited visibility into supplier channel adoption once work is in progress.

**Challenge** | Retailers need a faster way to review supplier connections, extract data for analysis and track onboarding progress without relying on multiple sources or unclear handoffs.

**What's New** | With 2026.2 we are strengthening retailer–vendor collaboration by introducing a centralized self-service space for supplier monitoring and clearer progress visibility into onboarding processes.

**Expected Benefits** | Faster onboarding cycles, where adoption stands, and higher-quality product data helping retailers get compliant listings sooner and helping suppliers reach “live” faster.

# AI-Powered Translations – Glossary Support

**Current Situation** | AI-powered translations in the Stibo Systems Platform rely on language models to infer meaning and terminology from context. While effective for general language, this can result in inconsistent translation of customer-specific terms such as brand names, technical vocabulary, and standard phrases.

**Challenge** | Without enforced terminology, reviewers must manually correct recurring issues to maintain brand and industry consistency. This increases review effort, slows translation workflows, and limits confidence when scaling AI translations across global catalogues.

**What's New** | With 2026.2, glossary support is introduced for AI translations, enabling customers to define approved source-to-target term mappings that the AI must follow. Configured for asynchronous AI translation services in the Workbench, these glossaries act as hard rules to enforce consistent terminology.

**Expected Benefits** | Improved consistency, reduced rework, and faster reviews, enabling customers to scale AI translations with greater confidence while preserving brand, technical, and domain-specific language.

# Enhancements to the Asynchronous Translations Framework

**Current Situation** | The asynchronous translation framework includes all reference types and object names in translation exports by default, even when they are not language-dependent. As a result, translation files are larger than necessary, include non-relevant content, and increase processing time and cost without improving translation value.

**Challenge** | Users lack control over what is translated versus what is included only as context or excluded entirely and translation files are unnecessarily large.

**What's New** | With 2026.2, the translation framework applies consistent inclusion, contextual, and exclusion rules across product attributes, reference metadata, and object names. All settings are managed centrally through the asynchronous translation service configuration.

**Expected Benefits** | Translation files are smaller, faster to process, and better aligned with user intent, reducing translation cost and turnaround time. Translators receive clearer, more relevant context without unnecessary noise, improving translation quality.

# Match Tuning by Data Owners

**Current Situation** | In [2026.1](#), we introduced a shared view of match accuracy and data-quality issues, so super users and data owners could review potential matches together. However, rule ownership still sits mainly with super users, so tuning can remain slow and dependent on specialist involvement.

**Challenge** | We still need a simpler, faster path from scores/pairs to clear decisions, thresholds, and a ruleset that runs in matching, without a heavy manual-review loop.

**What's New** | With 2026.2, data owners can create, manage, and activate match rulesets in collaboration with super users, directly in the Match Tuning app.

**Expected Benefits** | Faster tuning, fewer errors, and less manual review—plus clearer ownership and incremental rollout of decisions.

# Relevant Import and Export Configurations in List Processing

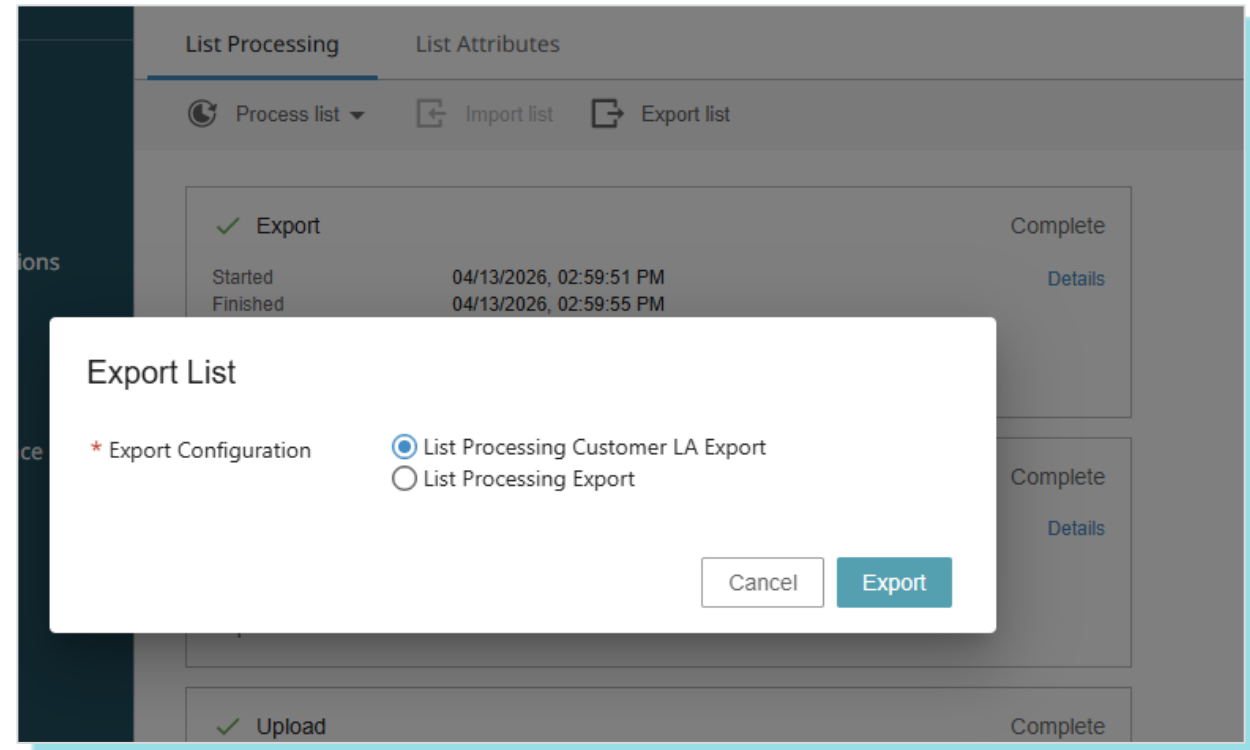

**Current Situation** | Users are overwhelmed with a large number of import and export configurations during creation or export of a list.

**Challenge** | It is exceedingly difficult to find the correct import or export configuration as all configurations are shown.

**What's New** | With 2026.2, List Processing now limits import and export configuration choices to those relevant for each **\*\*List Object Type\*\***, based on global Web UI configuration.

**Expected Benefits** | Users see only appropriate options for their lists, reducing clutter and mistakes, and making it easier to find the correct configuration.

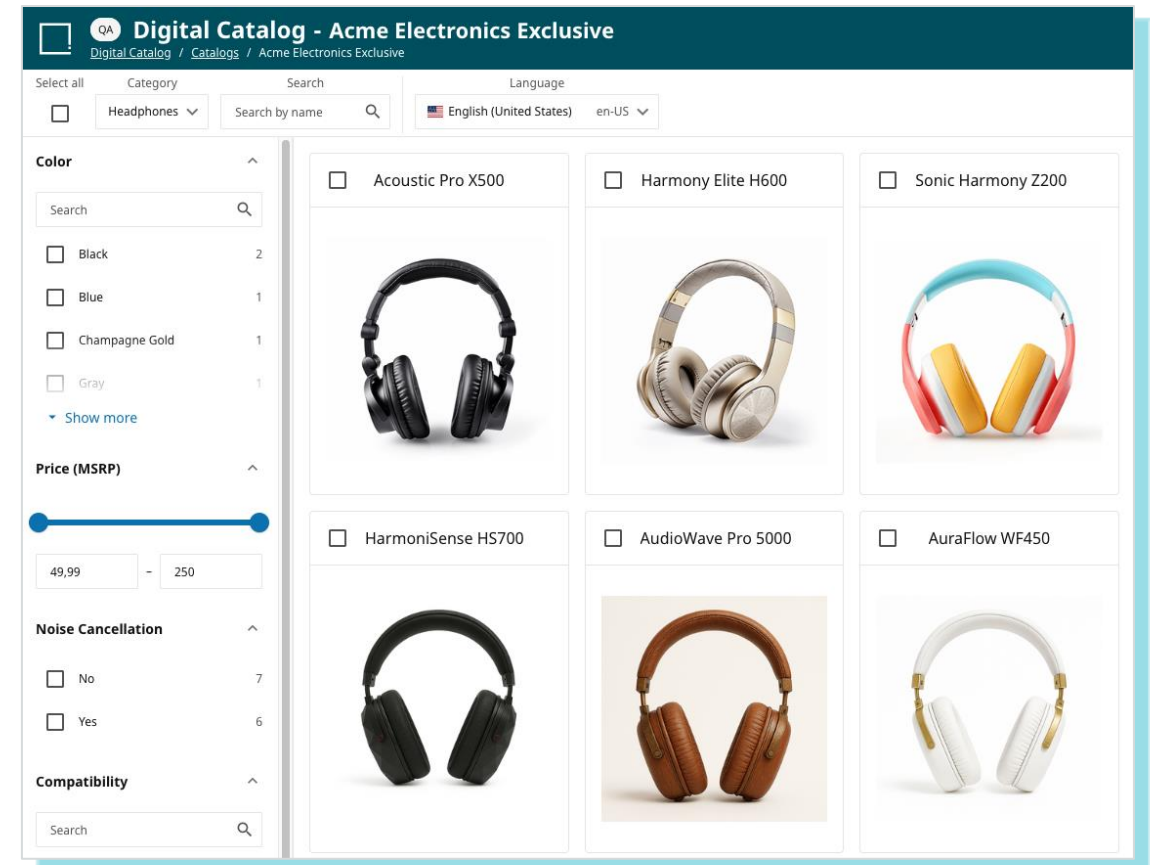
**Current Situation** | The Digital Catalog UI supports only English, has limited search and navigation, and offers a basic product page, making browsing difficult.

**Challenge** | Poor usability and missing features slows product identification and hinder adoption.

- UI Localization (German, French, Spanish, Italian, English)
- Improved search and intuitive navigation with faceted filtering
- Webshop-like product detail page with image carousel, enhanced content, and an export option

**Expected Benefits** | Delivering a modern, user-friendly catalog experience, accelerating product discovery and supporting global rollout to retail partners.

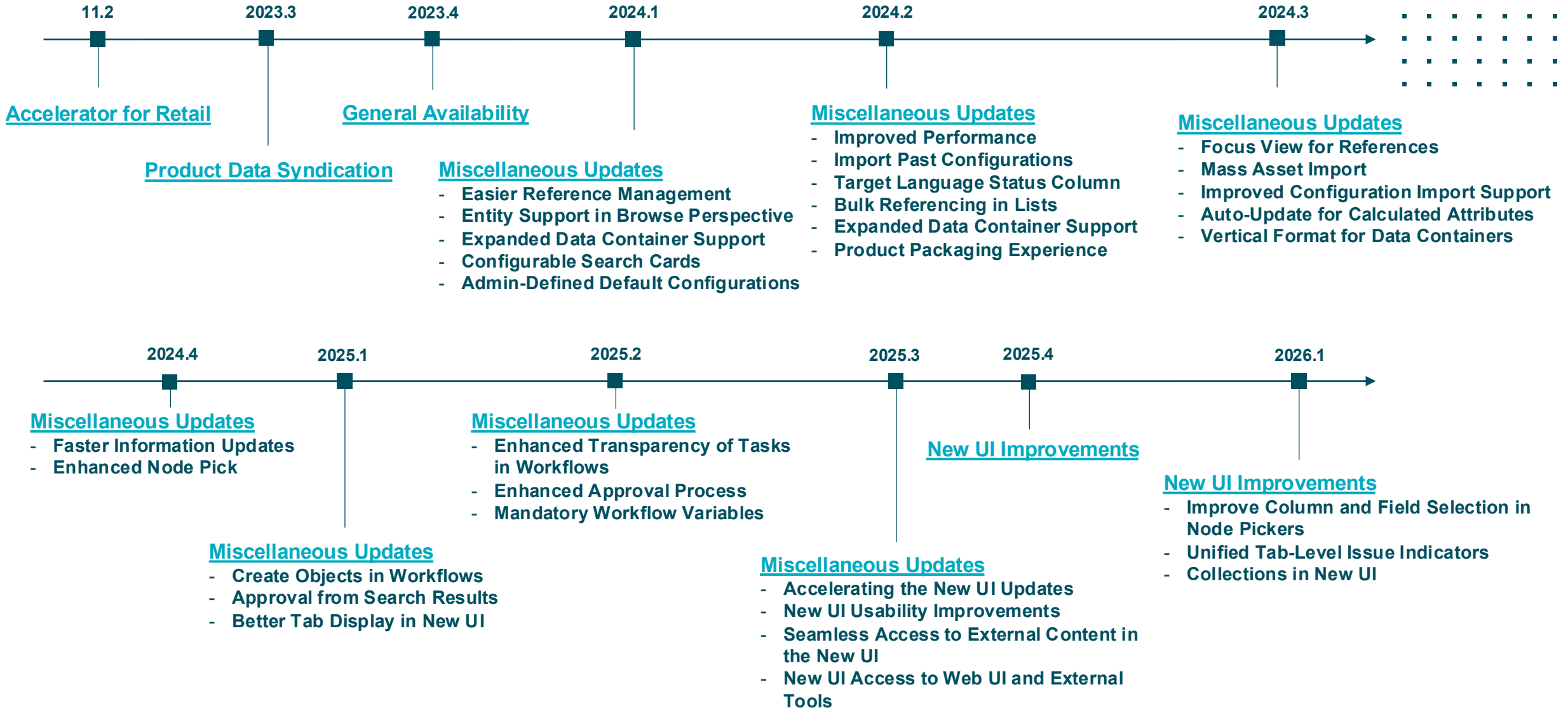
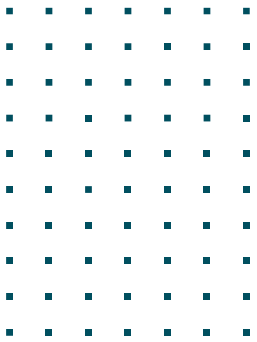

# New UI Included by Default for SaaSv2 Customers

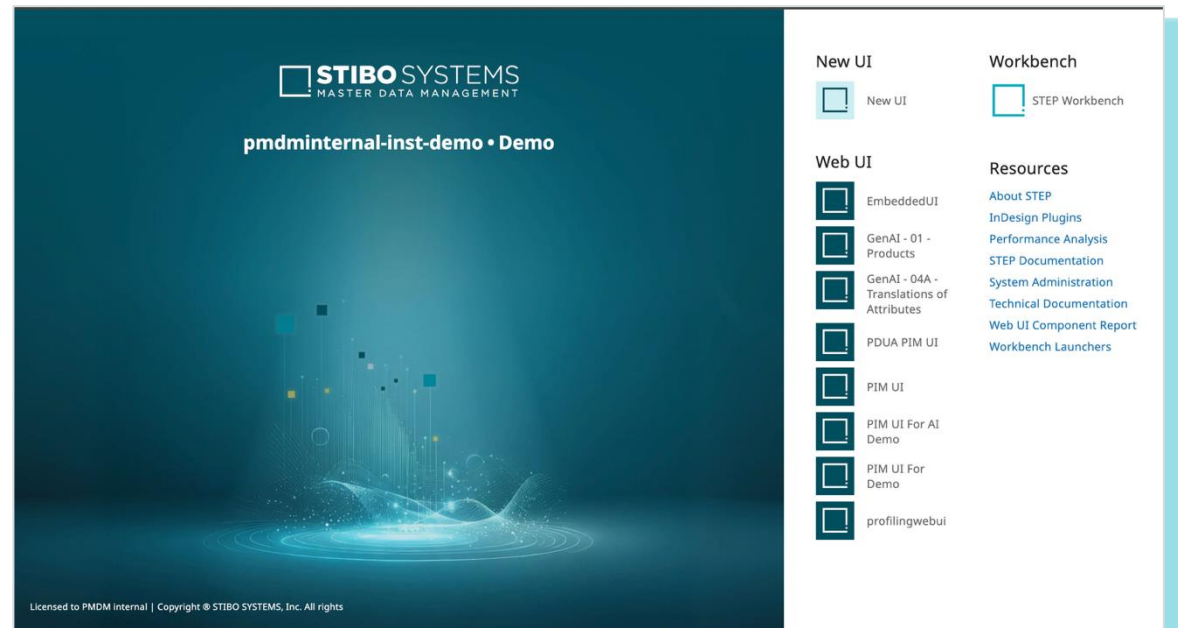
**Current Situation |** Today, access to the New UI requires a manual enablement step, where a \$0 order form must be submitted before a customer can try or use it. This adds unnecessary friction and delays, even though the New UI is positioned as the successor to the Web UI and the future frontend experience for the Stibo Systems Platform, starting with PXDC (PIM) use cases.

**Challenge |** The manual enablement process slows down adoption and creates unnecessary operational overhead.

**What's New |** Starting with 2026.2, the New UI is included in the base license for all SaaSv2 customers. No order forms or license flags will be needed. The New UI will be available by default, and customers can control which users have access through standard privilege management.

**Expected Benefits |** Less internal overhead, far less customer friction, and faster migration/exploration, while aligning the New UI as the default forward path for the Stibo Systems Platform.

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# Enhanced Overview for Complex Relationship Scenarios


**Current Situation** | The New UI supports working with product data and relationships and works well for simple scenarios. As data models evolve into more complex relationship scenarios, users increasingly need product data and related context to be understood together to maintain a clear overview.

**Challenge** | In complex relationship scenarios, understanding products and their relationships requires combining multiple types of information. When this context is spread across views, it becomes harder to maintain a holistic overview, work efficiency decreases, and managing complex data structures requires more effort and attention.

**What's New** | In 2026.2, relationship data are presented together with relevant product data and key information from related objects in a single, structured view. Enabling a more holistic, 360-degree overview for complex relationship scenarios, while still supporting simpler use cases without adding unnecessary complexity.

**Expected Benefits** | Better overview and understanding of complex relationship scenarios with less navigation and clearer context. Users can work more efficiently and confidently, improving data quality and reducing risk when managing relationship-heavy data.

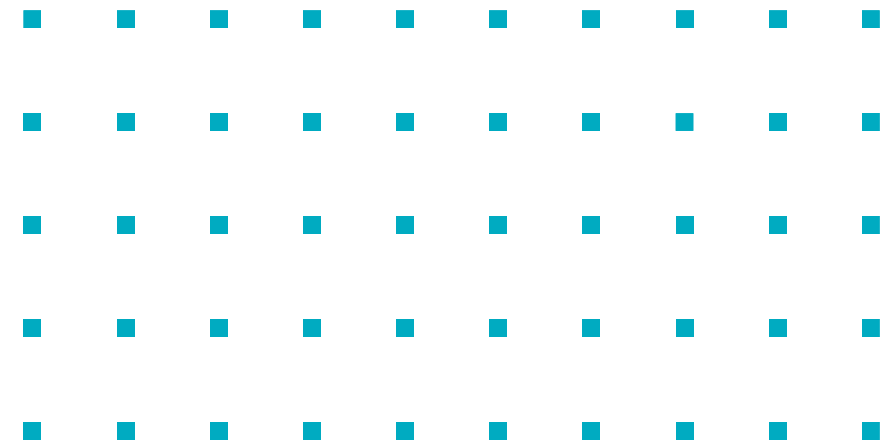

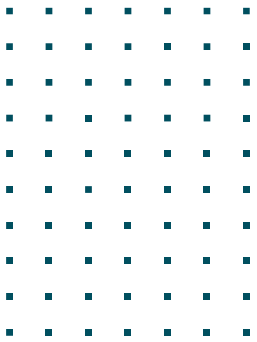

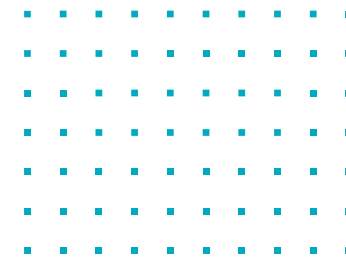
