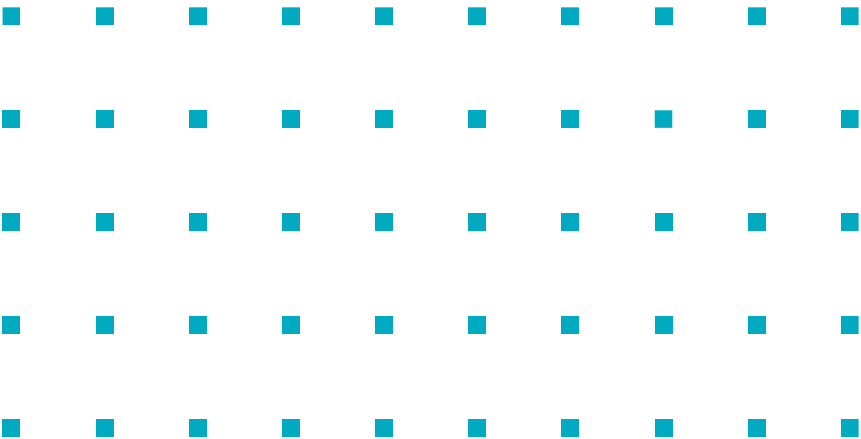

Figure 1: Magic Quadrant for Master Data Management Solutions



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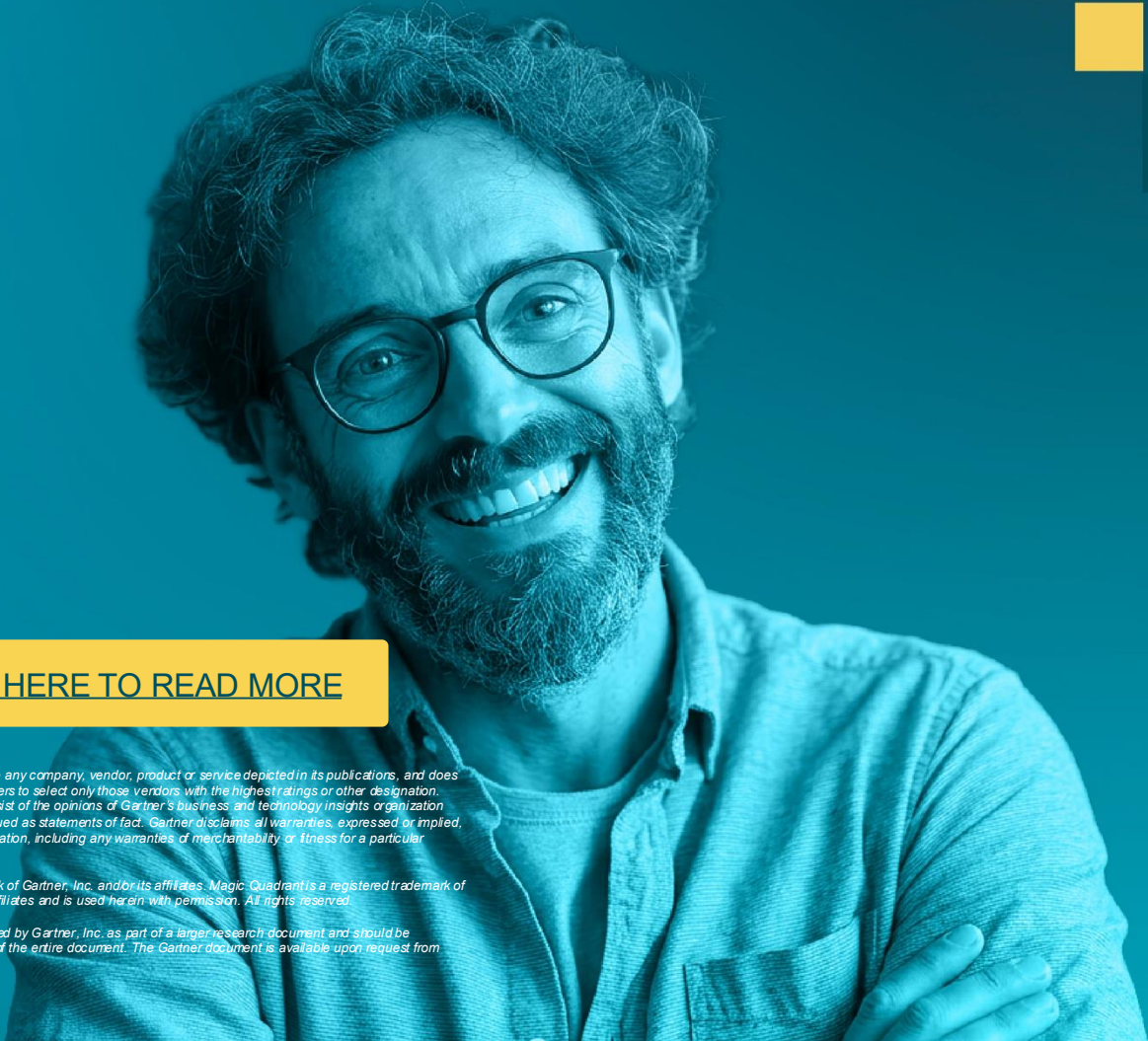

New UI CoPilot Interface

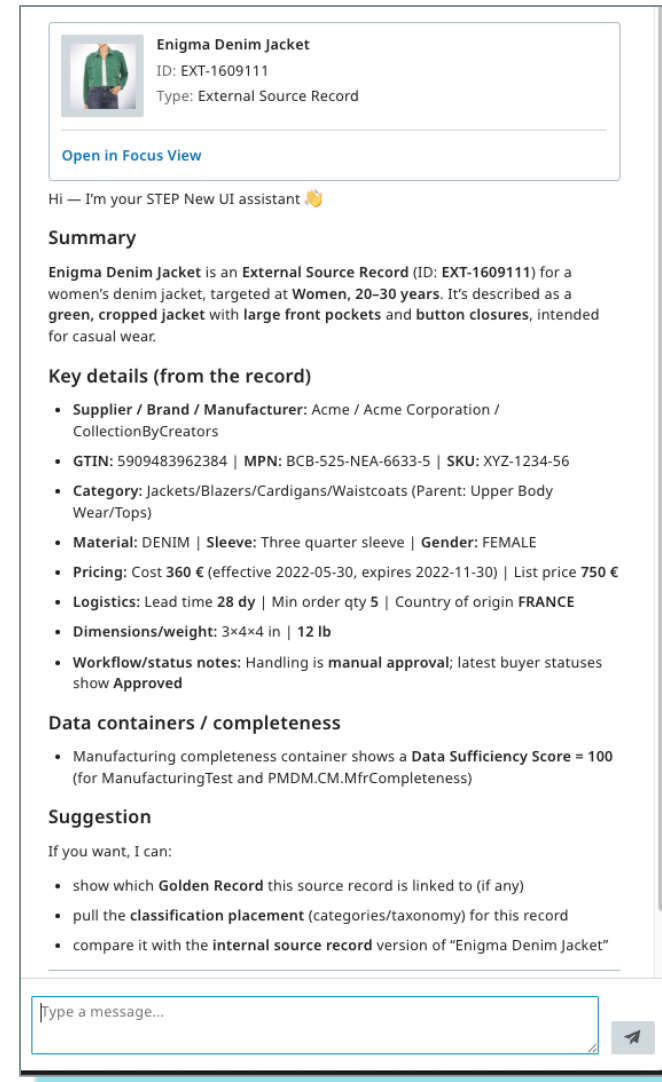
Current Situation | Today, finding product data may include navigating screens + tabs, starting searches, or understanding the Stibo Systems platform data model to find and correct necessary data.

Challenge | This slows down access to information and creates barriers for non-expert users, limiting productivity and accessibility.

What's New | In 2026.3, we will introduce a CoPilot chat interface in the New UI (Limited Availability):

- Search and explore products using natural language
- View product details, compare with other products in chat
- Ask for data quality validation
- Access clickable product links directly from responses
- Keep history of your preferences

Expected Benefits | Users will be able to find and explore product data faster and more intuitively, without navigating to screens. This will reduce time to retrieve and analyze data, make product data more approachable, and establish the foundation for broader AI capabilities in the New UI.

AI Prompt Creation

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Current Situation | Today, creating AI prompts requires technical setup and manual configuration, slowing adoption.

Challenge | Users can't easily create or manage prompts themselves, limiting flexibility and time to value.

What's New | In 2026.3, we will introduce New UI-based AI Prompt Creation (phase 1):

- Create, test, and manage prompts directly in the New UI
- Define inputs, outputs, and instructions without technical setup
- Apply prompts to product data (e.g. translation, content generation)

Expected Benefits | Customers will be able to quickly activate and scale AI use cases without technical dependencies, driving faster adoption, more consistent outputs, and a strong foundation for future AI automation.

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Enriching Product Data Across Contexts

Current Situation | Global customers need to manage product data that varies by context (e.g., language/country). In the New UI, users still have to switch contexts manually to view, edit, or compare data.

Challenge | This fragmented experience leads to inefficiencies, limited visibility, and increased risk of errors. It slows down localization, enrichment, and governance efforts, especially when working across multiple markets or teams.

What's New | With 2026.3, the Multi-Context Tab will be introduced through a phased rollout, with Phase 1 delivering better attribute value inheritance across the product and dimension hierarchy, along with the ability to view and maintain attribute values across multiple contexts within a unified interface.

Phase 2 in later releases will extend this capability to reference metadata across contexts.

Expected Benefits | Improved efficiency by reducing manual context switching and providing better visibility of localized, market-specific data in a single view. Side-by-side comparison and editing help reduce errors, improve consistency, and support faster decisions and smoother cross-team collaboration.

Enhanced Overview for Complex Relationship Scenarios

Current Situation | Getting a clear overview is key when working with relationships. However, when important data is spread across views, users are forced to navigate to understand the full picture, which reduces efficiency.

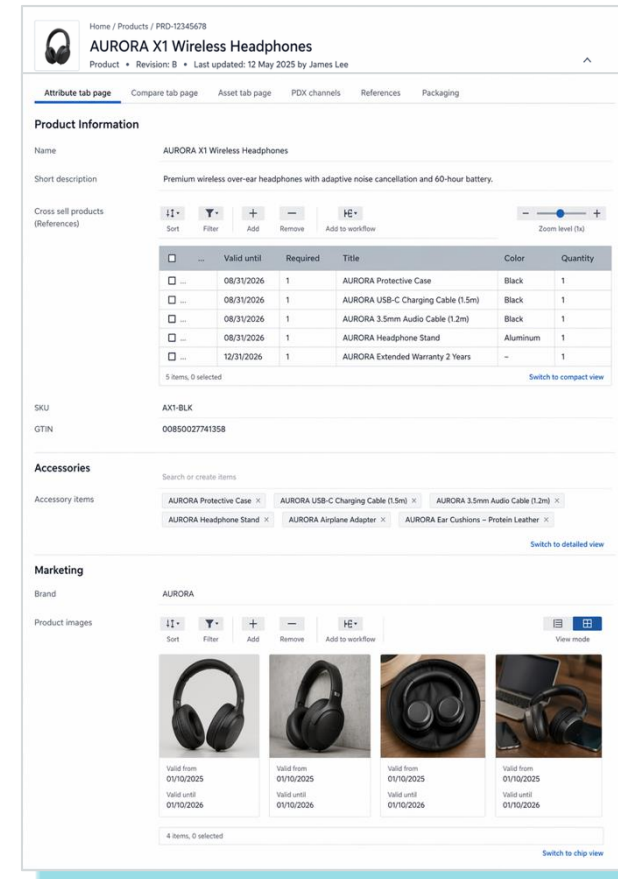
Challenge | Missing contextual data and lack of structured presentation become more critical as complexity increases, leading to unnecessary navigation and slower workflows in reference-heavy scenarios.

What's New | In 2026.3, references in the Details view will become structured and actionable to:

- Show referenced object data and reference metadata in context
- Support table, gallery, and chip views for different scenarios
- Enable inline add, edit, and remove of references
- Allow admin configuration of layout, order, and displayed data

Expected Benefits | Users will be able to manage relationships directly in the Details view, reducing navigation and effort while improving efficiency, data quality, and confidence in reference-heavy use cases.

Product Translations in New UI

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Current Situation | Global organizations need to manage and deliver localized product data across multiple languages and regions, but the New UI lacks an efficient way to view, edit, and approve translations.

Challenge | This leads to fragmented workflows, manual overhead, and limited visibility into multilingual content, slowing localization, increasing error risk, and delaying time to market.

What's New | With 2026.3, a new Translation tab will be introduced, enabling users to review and approve translations across multiple target languages within a single, unified interface with predefined source-target relationships.

In future releases, this tab will be expanded to support reference metadata and creation of translation relationships.

Expected Benefits | Streamlined multilingual workflows, improved translation accuracy and consistency, faster localization and time to market, stronger multilingual data governance, and enhanced collaboration across global teams.

PIES 8.0 Support

Current Situation | Automotive customers rely on PIES for product data exchange, and with the official release of PIES 8.0 in March 2026 by Auto Care, there is growing pressure to adopt the latest standard.

Challenge | PIES 8.0 files cannot be reliably processed currently, leading to failures, data inconsistencies, and reliance on workarounds.

What's New | With 2026.3, the Stibo Systems Platform will support PIES 8.0, including updated schema definitions across key segments, alignment of importer and exporter with version-aware processing, and support for new capabilities such as digital asset file hashing and sequencing, multi-package handling, and extended packaging information (EPR).

Expected Benefits | Seamless exchange using the latest standard, reduced risk of import failures and data inconsistencies, support for richer and more compliant product data, and stronger alignment with evolving automotive data standards.

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New ACES[®] 5.0, PIES[®] 8.0, VCdb, Qdb, PCdb, PAdb and Brand Table Versions Announced for Industry Review!

The Technology Standards Committee (TSC) and the Auto Care Association are pleased to announce the following new Schema Versions for a one-year industry review:

- ACES[®] 5.0
- PIES[®] 8.0
- VCdb 2.0
- Qdb 2.0
- PCdb 2.0
- PAdb 5.0
- Brand Table 2.0

The one-year industry review period is a time for users to review, test, and implement these new versions into their systems before these versions become official. Additionally, users are asked to report any errors found in these new versions to [Contact Us](#) or post them in the comments below.

These new schema versions will be implemented and become official versions on **March 26, 2026***

**On March 26, 2026, old versions of the VCdb, Qdb, PCdb, PAdb and Brand Table will no longer be supported. For ACES and PIES, only the current versions and one version previous (ACES 4.2 and PIES 7.2) will be supported.*

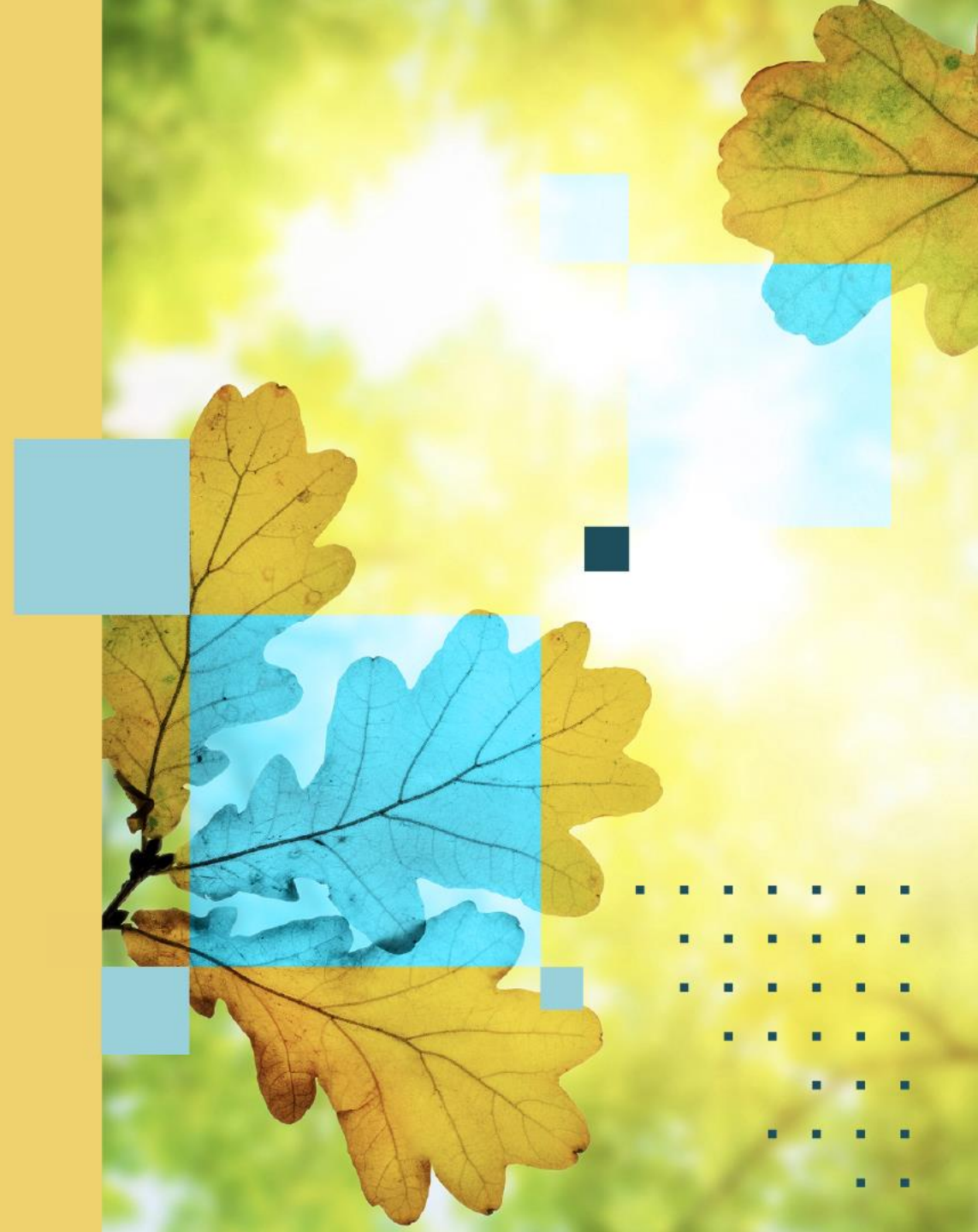
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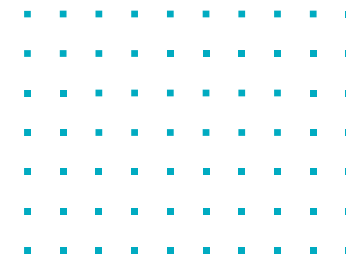
